Soundtruism Ltd follows the BBC's [Child Protection Policies](#) and has completed training by the BBC's Child protection and safeguarding senior advisor in Nov 2020.

Soundtruism is therefore familiar with the BBC's procedures around:

Compliance with the BBC's Child Protection Policy and the BBC Code of Conduct - Ten Golden Rules to guide behaviour when around children and young people.

Guidance and procedures as part of the BBC Child Protection and Safeguarding policies & procedures and the BBC Working with Children App available via BBC Essentials.

Specific guidance on Licensing and working hours, gaining Consent along with the BBC Editorial Policy and Guidance around working with children and young people and guidance regarding Social Media and Online Safety have also been covered.

Guidance for working with Chaperones along with the NSPCC online course: Protecting children in entertainment: a course for chaperones has also been looked at and covered.

Where staff and others are working with children it is important that they are competent and have received the correct training.

Editorial Lead and Managing Director for Soundtruism, Nina Robinson has an up to date DBS / Self Declaration and has contacts with Working with Children Advisers across the BBC who she knows are available to assist with ongoing queries.

Soundtruism also has the BBC's Working with Children Risk Assessment forms and is familiar with how to complete them.
